Lao PDR full reopening and relaxed measures from 9 May 2022

### **NOTICE**

**Re:** Guidance on Lao PDR entry-exit measures and relaxed measures in the country during the COVID-19 pandemic.

- Pursuant to Decree No 574/PMO dated 28 September 2021 regarding organization and activities of the Prime Minister's Office.
- Based on actual implementation of travel entry-exit policies of countries in the region and around the world.
- Based on reviews of public opinion on Lao PDR entry-exit measures during the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Based on research and proposal by the Taskforce for COVID-19 Prevention, Control and Response to COVID-19 pandemic (COVID-19 Taskforce).

The Prime Minister's Office is pleased to announce the Government's decision and guidance for your information and implementation as follows:

# 1. Agree to relax Lao PDR entry-exit measures as follows:

- 1) Open all international borders to Lao citizens, aliens, foreigners, and stateless persons to enter and exit Lao PDR.
- 2) Permit citizens of countries granted visa waiver under bilateral and unilateral agreements to enter Lao PDR without visa requests.
- 3) Citizens of countries not eligible for visa waiver with Lao PDR can apply for a visa with an embassy or consular of the Lao PDR overseas or apply for an evisa or visa upon entry at international borders as available.
- 4) Lao citizens, aliens, foreigners, and stateless persons over twelve years of age without complete vaccination certificate must have a rapid (ATK) COVID-19 certificate within 48 hours of departure. There will be no testing/sample collection at airports or international borders via road or boat when entering Lao PDR. Person with a complete [COVID-19] vaccination certificate can enter Lao PDR as usual without requiring COVID-19 testing both at the country of departure and upon entry to Lao PDR.
- 5) Foreigners entering Lao PDR who contract COVID-19 shall be responsible for all treatment costs, which can be at a public hospital, private hospital or home isolation as provided in the Instruction by the Ministry of Health.

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- **2. Agree to allow use of vehicles to enter-exit Lao PDR as in the pre-COVID period.** The Ministry of Public Works and Transport is assigned to issue an Instruction regarding the use of personal, passenger, and tour vehicles to enterexit Lao PDR that is consistent with bilateral and multilateral agreements that Lao PDR is signatory.
- 3. Ministries, ministry-equivalent organizations and local administrations at all level and businesses to be prepared in all areas for welcoming tourists especially improving tourist sites, hotels, restaurants, transportation services, and other services associated with tourism and hospitality to ensure better standard and quality. Tourism and hospitality should be considered a collective responsibility of everyone in the society for economic recovery and people's improved livelihood.
- **4. Agree for the reopening of entertainment venues and karaoke bars**, with strict implementation of COVID-19 preventive measures.
- **5.** Assign the COVID-19 Taskforce to collaborate with the Ministry of Health in closely monitoring and surveilling outbreak of new COVID-19 variant to ensure effective and efficient prevention, control, testing, and treatment. At the same time, focus on vaccine administration to meet set targets.
- 6. Measures stipulated in item 1 to 5 above are effective from 9 May 2022 onwards.
